Busan International Film Festival

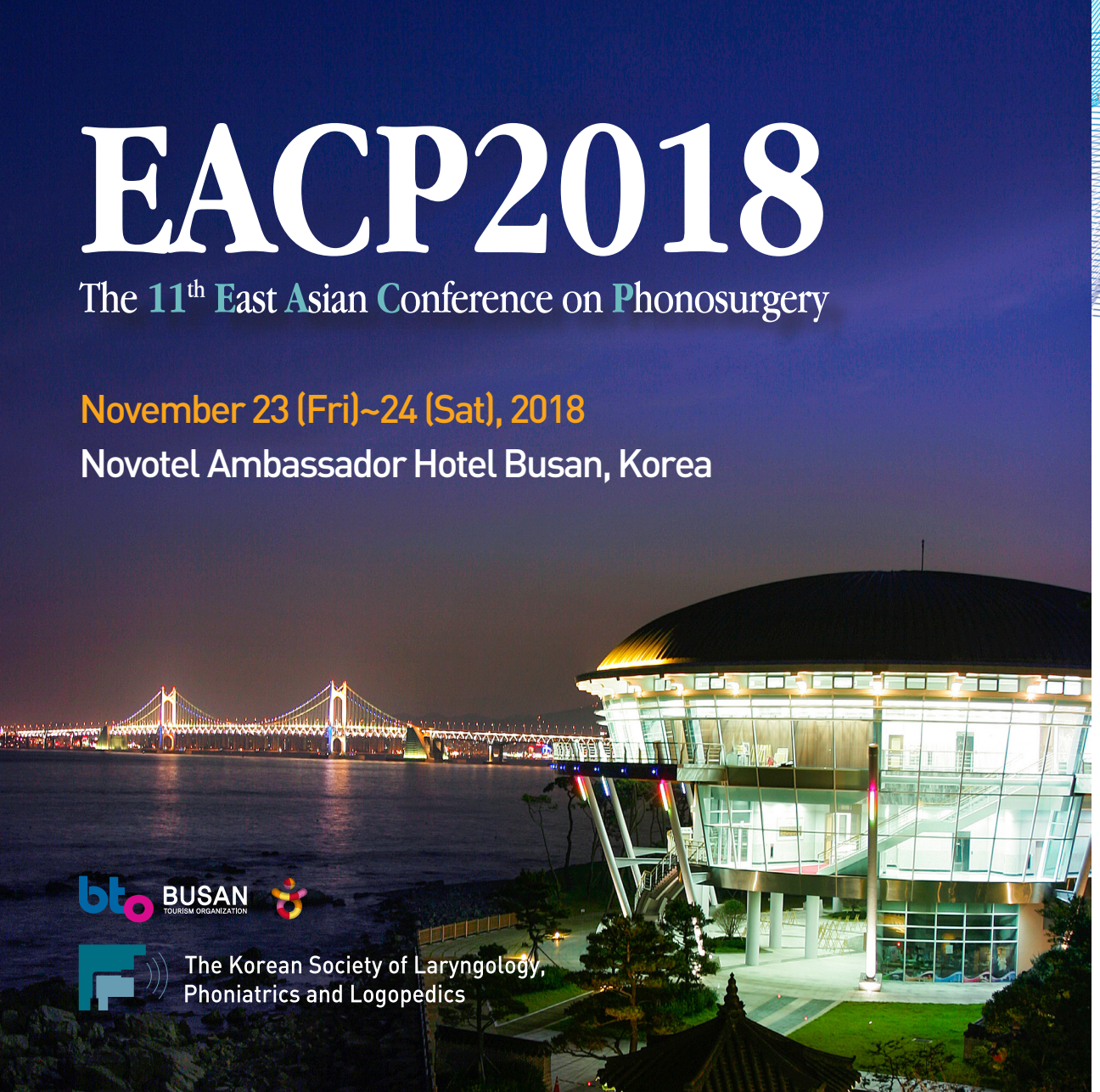
